




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Before you begin...

there are a few things you should know.

If you received a letter from the school saying that your children were automatically approved (directly certified) for free meals for the 2020-2021 school year because someone in your household participates in Food Assistance (FA), Family Investment Program (FIP), or Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPRI) then you do not need to submit an application.

If you decide you do not want to complete an application electronically, paper applications are available at your child's school.

We only need one application for all of the children in your household that attend school in your district.

Eligibility for free or reduced price school meal benefits is based on any one of the three things:

- your child's individual status as foster, homeless, migrant or runaway, or
- participation in an assistance program by any member of your household
- your total household income and size is at or below the limits on the Federal Income Eligibility Guidelines below
